

Supervising First Aid for Mental Health Training Course

Live online learning offered during COVID-19

This short course provides learners with an in-depth understanding of mental health conditions and the ability to identify suspected concerns. Delegates will also learn about the support and help provided by healthcare professionals.

The Supervising First Aid for Mental Health Level 3 qualification advances on the learnings from Level 1 and 2. The course is aimed at supporting those currently working in supervisory, managerial and leadership roles.

The interactive online workshop is delivered by qualified tutors, each with a background of working within the mental health industry. All learning resources are included.

Duration

This will be delivered over 15 hours (three sessions of 5 hours each) in a virtual classroom environment.

A small amount of self-study is required and learners will also be required to spend some time preparing for their assessment prior to the completion of the course.

Number of Delegates

First Aid for Mental Health is delivered at Levels 1, 2 and 3, across three separate learning sessions. Learners completing Level 1 only need to attend the first session. Learners completing Level 2 need to attend the first two sessions. Finally, learners completing Level 3 need to attend all three sessions.

A maximum of 20 delegates per tutor are allowed on the course. Learners must be a minimum of 18 years of age due to the requirement to video record the final assessment in line with First Aid Awards (FAA) regulations.

Certification

A Level 3 Award in Supervising First Aid for Mental Health will be issued to the learner, subject to successful assessment. This qualification is valid for three years from the date of achievement. It is strongly recommended that the learner attends annual refresher training. The learner will need to complete the full course again to re-qualify for a further three years.

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Structure

Assessment

The assessment for this course will be completed remotely. The Professional Discussion assessment will be carried out remotely by video between the learner and course tutor. The time allowed for this assessment is one hour. Learners will be given an agenda and time to prepare for the discussion, where they will be supported to discuss what they have learned on the course. Learners will also be required to simulate with their trainer carrying out the First Aid for Mental Health Action Plan, which they will be trained to do during the course. The assessment will be recorded to meet FAA requirements.
